

Instructions to Authors

1. The aim of this journal is to publish the research papers of members from both associations, "Agricultural Chemical Society of Taiwan" and "Taiwan Association for Food Science and Technology."
2. Submission of an **original paper** (not more than 6000 words) or **research note** implies that it has not been published previously (except in the form of an abstract or as part of a published lecture or academic thesis), that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere, and that, if accepted, it will not be published elsewhere in the same form without the written consent of the Publisher. The manuscripts written in either **Chinese** or **English** are accepted.
3. The manuscript must be typed double-spaced, **labeled page and line numbers**, and arranged according to the following format: **ABSTRACT, INTRODUCTION, MATERIALS AND METHODS, RESULTS, DISCUSSION or RESULTS AND DISCUSSION, CONCLUSIONS, ACKNOWLEDGMENTS, REFERENCES, Corresponding Chinese Abstract** (if manuscript is written in English).
4. **Pagination.** Page sequence of articles should be as follows:
Title page. Topic should not exceed 40 words and typed in capitals of initial of each word, full name(s) of author(s) of capitals of initial, administrative unit/department/section contact person, and address, telephone and fax numbers and e-mail address for correspondence. The corresponding author should be identified with an asterisk and footnote. Please give a short "Running title" of manuscript.
Second page. Both single paragraph abstracts written in English (not exceeding 300 words) and in Chinese (not exceeding 500 words), reporting concisely on the purpose and results of the paper. A list of key words should be provided.
Third page. Complete text, references, tables, figure captions, figures.
5. **Nomenclature**
Current recognized (IUPAC) chemical nomenclature should be used, although commonly accepted trivial names may be used where there is no risk of ambiguity.
6. Photographs, charts and diagrams are all to be referred to as "Figure(s)". They should accompany the manuscript, but should not be included within the text. All illustrations should be clearly marked with the figure number and the author's name. All figures are to have a caption. Captions should be supplied on a separate sheet. Tables should be numbered consecutively and given a suitable caption and each table typed on a separate sheet. Footnotes to tables should be typed below the table and should be referred to by superscript lowercase letters. No vertical rules should be used. Tables should not duplicate results presented elsewhere in the manuscript (e.g. in graphs).
7. **References.** References should be listed on a separate sheet and numbered in the order in which they are cited in the text. References should be cited in the text by a superscript number in parentheses, for example, ⁽¹⁾.
Journals: initials followed by author(s)' last name(s); complete title; journal title, volume number, first and last page numbers; year of publication.
Example:

Books: initials followed by author(s)' last name(s); complete title; edition and volume; name of editor; first and last page numbers; publisher; place of publication; year of publication.
Example:

8. **Number of copies.** Submit the complete and original manuscript in triplicate. Photographic materials must be original prints. After reviewed and accepted, two copies of final revised version accompany **with the disc containing full text, all tables and figures must be mailed to the Editor-in-Chief.**

9. Proofs and reprints

Proofs. Galley proofs are made available to only the corresponding author of a paper. It is the responsibility of the corresponding author to ascertain that all coauthors agree with the corrections before the corrections are returned

Reprints. Fifty reprints will be supplied free of charge if total pages are not more than four pages. Author(s) must responsible for the charge of extra and color pages. Additional reprints and copies of the issue can be ordered at a specially reduced rate by contacting publisher.

10. Copyright

Upon submitting the manuscript, authors will be asked to transfer copyright (for copyright agreement letter download please see <http://www.agrichem.org.tw> or www.food.org.tw) to the associations. The copyright agreement must be mailed to editor-in-chief before reviewing process is proceeded. If excerpts from other copyrighted works are included, the author(s) must obtain written permission from the copyright owners and credit the source(s) in the article.
